We are less than a month into the new year and we are already moving at lightning speed. Nell and I had a promotion in Denver on January 5th and then I raced back to camp for our Bible study writers' retreat. Since then, I've had two more promotion Sundays and we have been preparing for recruiting our summer staff in Colorado and the Midwest. We will leave for the Midwest in early February.

We have had incredibly strong early registrations for our summer on-site programs. Four weeks are already full with two more getting close to full. We are close to 1,000 campers already registered for this summer and we are still in January. This is the fastest our camps have filled in over 15 years. Don't wait to register! Take a look at which week will work for your child and register now. It will be a life-changing



week for your kids! See if week 10 will work for your schedule. It is one of our best weeks of the summer! And bring a friend with you to share the experience. We are expanding the group of campers for that week to create a Beloved Community that includes kids of different abilities. We also have 37 day camps scheduled that will be happening out in the congregations. There is still room for your senior high youth to go on a Compass Points backpacking trip or Bridging Borders service trip this summer. Contact Maggie Brakke or Cam Regennitter respectively for more information on these programs.

The Bristlecone Lodge remodel is moving forward. We spent the better part of a week clearing out all of beds, mattresses, furniture, accounting history boxes, and artwork from BC. It looks very different! Construction will begin any day. We will keep you updated as things progress!

Many people think that church camp is a nice "extra" in their child's summer. But it is so much more. I hear from campers over and over again about how camp has solidified their faith and really equipped them to be Christ's light in the world. Camp changes people in some amazing ways. I want every child to experience that wonderfully loving and grace-filled community. Money should never be the reason any child doesn't come to RTLC. So, don't let that be a barrier. The first question to ask is "Do you want your child to go to camp?" That is a yes/no question. If your answer is yes, then, together, let's figure out a way to get them there. If you are in a position where finances will prevent you from sending your child to camp, please contact me—we'll find a way to get your child to camp! We have very generous donors that have given specifically to provide camperships for this exact reason. Do this for your child. If you want your kids or family to come to camp this summer, we will find a way to make that happen!

We have begun our recruiting tour to find our 2020 summer staff. We have already visited the Colorado state schools and have talked with some great candidates. We will be heading to the Midwest on February 3rd for two weeks. Cam, Maggie, and I will be traveling together this year. I ask for your prayers as we travel. I also ask for your prayers for the whole selection process. We are anticipating a strong group of returning staff from last summer's crew that will make a solid foundation for this summer. This is always a fun time of the year as the summer ministry team starts taking shape. We know God has great plans for this new ministry team that is forming!

The Land Exchange is moving forward! The Forest Service has begun work on their land exchange feasibility analysis. The feasibility analysis will run to the end of 2020. There are still opportunities to support this effort. We have calculated that we will still need to raise around \$199,000 to cover all of the remaining costs of the 64 steps of the actual exchange. We will do one last fundraising push for the Land exchange after we receive the positive results from the Forest Service feasibility analysis. Please keep this land exchange in your prayers.

2019 was another great year for our ministry. Our programs continued to be very full; we had an amazing summer staff; we continued to systematically upgrade our site including starting the remodel of Bristlecone Lodge; and we had phenomenal support for this ministry—through financial gifts, prayer, and the gift of people's time. None of this would have happened without you. I am truly humbled by the generosity of our supporters this past fall. I know we asked a lot between the BC remodel and Colorado Gives Day. Even so, you gave over \$230,000 to these two projects in less than four months. This is incredible! Thank you all for supporting for this ministry and for me as your director.

I want to personally thank Sam Berglund for her years of service to Rainbow Trail. During Sam's time at RTLC, Compass Points grew to the largest number of people served through that ministry. Sam also really became a partner with the Day Camp coordinators in providing a great experience for the campers through their specific congregations. Sam, know that these programs have your fingerprint all over them. Thanks for serving boldly and being an integral part of our full-time team for four and half years! We'll miss you! I attended two celebration of life services this past Saturday. These were people who were important in the life of the RTLC community. Tom Guinn was a pastor in our Synod for 56 years and was a key player in keeping Rainbow Trail open in the late 60's when tough decisions about the viability of this ministry needed to be made. Sandy Kistler loved Rainbow Trail, had been a camper growing up, and shared it with her kids. Her daughter Heather worked for us for five summers It was an emotionally draining day, but as part of the sermon at Tom's service, Pastor Ron Bock shared a keen insight. "I think we know God better because we knew Tom." I would say the same about Sandy. Our prayers continue to be with both the Guinn and Kistler families. This year has started off with a bang. I am so excited for what lies ahead and all the possibilities. Please pray for this ministry and for our staff. We take great joy in serving you through RTLC. I am beginning my 32nd year at Rainbow Trail. I could not have asked for a better place to live over half my life and have the opportunity to serve you with all of my gifts. Nellie and my circle of friends stems from this RTLC community. You have all become an integral part of our story. Thanks for being my partner all along the way! I can't wait to see what God has planned for us in 2020!



My BFF Carol has been taking care of me, the animals and the house. I think she needs a vacation! This time of year is historically slow. Of course, that was before the whirlwind Daniel took over as Director of retreats! So many new people and retreats. Our family continues to grow! I will be back to work in March; just in time for the Sheridan Ski Retreat. Love my Nebraska people! Just a side note here... someone needs to make me a t-shirt that says, ROBO COOK!

So, in my downtime, I have become very interested in various forms of holistic healing that involve foods and herbs. I would like to share some with you.

Worldwide studies show that a mixture made of apple cider vinegar, garlic, and honey can help prevent or cure almost any ailment under the sun, including Alzheimer's disease, arthritis, asthma, high blood pressure, obesity, ulcers, and cancer, as well as muscle aches and colds. The simple formula: Mix 1 cup of apple cider vinegar, 1 cup of honey, and 8 peeled garlic cloves in a blender on high speed for 60 seconds. Pour into a glass jar that has a tight-fitting lid, and refrigerate it for 5 days. Then every day before breakfast take 2 teaspoons of the mixture stirred into a glass of water or juice. Works best with fresh orange or 100% grape juice.

Quite a few people send requests for recipes; so I try to choose the most requested one. Once again the banana cookie recipe wins! Katie Briley in Australia, this is for you, with love!

You will need, 3 ¹/₂c. flour, 1 tsp. Baking powder, ¹/₄ tsp. Baking soda, $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp.salt, $\frac{1}{2}$ c. soft butter, $\frac{1}{2}$ c. shortening, 1c. White sugar, $\frac{1}{2}$ c. brown sugar, 2 eggs, 2 tsp. Vanilla, 1 c. mashed, ripe bananas. For the frosting, you will need, 1/2c. Packed brown sugar, 1/3c. ½ and ½ or evaporated milk, 1/4c. Butter, 1/8tsp. Salt, 2 1/2c. Powdered sugar (approx.). For the cookies, preheat oven to 375f. Sift together the flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt. Set aside. In a large bowl, cream together the butter, sugar and brown sugar. Beat in the eggs, one at a time, then stir in the vanilla and bananas. Mix in the dry stuff till just blended. Don't overmix or you will have a dense instead of a light textured cookie! Drop by tsp. Onto parchment-lined cookie sheets and bake for 10-13 min. Till bottoms are light brown. Don't Overbake! As soon as your cookies are in the oven, start your frosting. You want to put warm frosting on warm cookies; Yum! In a saucepan. on low heat melt the butter, add sugars, milk, and salt. Increase heat to med. High and bring to a rolling boil stirring constantly. Cook for 2min. Without stirring. Remove from heat and sift in enough powdered sugar to make a slightly runny frosting. You want to have the frosting cover the warm cookies when you spoon it on. This is a high altitude recipe. To adapt for regular altitude, increase baking powder to 2tsp., and reduce flour to 3 1/4c. You could add 1c. Chocolate chips or coconut. Make it your own! I would like to close this article by welcoming the lovely Maggie Jean to our full-time staff as Director of Compass Points! If you have not had the chance to meet her yet, you are in for a treat! So until next time, remember... GOD IS GREAT!!!
