YOU ARE AMAZING!Rainbow Trail Community Sustains RTLC in a Challenging Year

You may have heard it said that it is in the midst of great challenges that you see what people are really made of. This has never rung more true than it did in 2020. What could have been an insurmountably challenging year for our ministry turned into an indescribable outpouring of support for the ministries of Rainbow Trail like we have never, ever experienced. Who would have thought we would be saying that in the midst of a global pandemic? The Rainbow Trail community gave and gave again to ensure that we would be ready to lead great ministry in 2021. We are beyond grateful and are humbled by your generosity. We can honestly say we would not be here if it were not for you. We made a huge commitment to our 2020 summer staff to hire



them and pay them no matter how the summer played out. We were able to raise \$160,000 to cover ALL of our summer staff salaries. We completed the remodel of Bristlecone Lodge and because of you, the remodel is fully paid for. And then Colorado Gives Day happened. Colorado Gives Day

raised \$108,537 for our annual fund! This is the highest amount we have ever raised from Colorado Gives. Congregations, who we know have been affected by this pandemic as well, gave over \$100,000 to support this ministry. Finally, we included

a \$10,000 matching gift in our Christmas letter which helped inspire 621 gifts in the month of December alone, the most for a single month ever. Trailblazer, Pathfinder and Contributor gifts were all the highest we have ever received for each category, raising a total of close to \$540,000.

You have been a blessing to so many: the campers that were able to come last summer, the retreaters that were able to come this past fall, and all of the campers and families that will be joining us this coming summer in 2021. Thank you for believing in this ministry and stepping to the line when we needed you most. We are ready and excited for all that 2021 holds for this ministry because of you. YOU ARE AMAZING!

Even though things are different, many things are the same. Vaccines are coming, people are registering for camp, we are recruiting and interviewing folks for summer staff, and we are going to have summer camp! It has been a very busy start of the new year, a year full of hope and promise!

We have had great registrations for our summer on-site programs. One week is already full with two more getting close to full. We have over 850 campers already registered for this summer and it is still early. But don't wait to register! Take a look at which week will work for your child and register now. It will be a lifechanging week for your kids! We also have 33 day camps scheduled that will be happening out in the congregations. There is still room for your



senior high youth to go on a Compass Points backpacking trip or Bridging Borders service trip this summer. Contact Maggie Brakke or Cam Regennitter respectively for more information on these programs.

Many people think that church camp is a nice "extra" in their child's summer. But it is so much more. I hear from campers over and over again about how camp has solidified their faith and really equipped them to be Christ's light in the world. Camp changes people in some amazing ways. I want every child to experience that wonderfully loving and grace-filled community. Money should never be the reason any child doesn't come to RTLC. So, don't let that be a barrier. The first question to ask is "Do you want your child to go to camp?" That is a yes/no question. If your answer is yes, then, together, let's figure out a way to get them there. If you are in a position where finances will prevent you from sending your child to camp, please contact me—we'll find a way to get your child to camp! We have very generous donors that have given specifically to provide camperships for this exact reason. Do this for your child. If you want your kids or family to come to camp this summer, we will find a way to make that happen! This year, more than ever, kids need the socialization of camp and to be in community again. Let camp help your kids and family transition out of this time of isolation. We'd love to see you!

The Land Exchange is moving forward, even if it is slow! The Forest Service has completed the draft of their land exchange feasibility analysis and it is in the supervisor's office for review. We hope to have an affirmative response from them before summer. At that point, we will start the actual land exchange which will take about two years to complete. We are getting close!!. There are still opportunities to support this effort. We have calculated that we will still need to raise around \$180,000 to cover all of the remaining costs of the 64 steps of the actual exchange. We will do one last fundraising push for the Land Exchange after we receive the affirmative response from the Forest Service. Please keep this Land Exchange in your prayers.

The Bristlecone Lodge remodel is done!! It is gorgeous! I can't wait to get you out to camp and show it off. BC will be able serve us well for many years to come. This may be the crown jewel of Kyle Larson's leadership with our site and facilities. As hard and challenging as last year was, 2020 was a great year for our ministry. We were able to run five weeks of actual on-site camp along with four weeks of virtual "on-site" camp. We also provided virtual day camp for 27 congregations. And maybe just as big, we were able to bring our whole summer staff in to provide ministry and we were able to pay them all. Your generosity will be the story that is told about 2020. The financial support we received was unbelievable! Through supporting staff salaries, Bristlecone Lodge, and Colorado Gives Day, you made a very bold statement of the value and importance of RTLC in your lives. Thank you all for supporting this ministry and for supporting me as your director.

I want to publicly thank Kyle Larson for his service to Rainbow Trail. We often talk about RTLC culture, and Kyle's legacy will be that he was instrumental in our culture becoming part of EVERY aspect of our ministry. In many camps, the area of site and facilities is often a maintenance job with very little interaction with people or even with ministry. But here, Site and Facilities is a key part of our ministry and the fact that campers can come to Skunk Cabbage, share a dream for their Village of the Day, and then cool and amazing props appear the next day speaks volumes. Adults are listening to kids, and helping their ideas come to fruition. Our site has been transformed during Kyle's time with us. Kyle and I were talking and I think he has touched and improved every single building on our site. Kyle had a vision of what our site could be, and then pushed me to find the funds to make that happen. We had great trust and a great partnership. I consider him a close friend. We will miss you dearly Kyle!

Great news that we have just received is that because we are licensed child care, our full-time and summer staff fall in the 1B group (below the dotted line) to get vaccinated. Our full-time team falls in right behind teachers in late February, and our summer staff will be sometime in March or April. This is a game changer in how we will be able to serve. We are planning in person Day Camps this year and are expecting a full slate of weeks on-site in 2021. We have a summer of experience to build on as we serve. We'll keep it safe. Kids need to be at camp!!

We have started recruiting our summer staff. We did a small loop through the Colorado schools, and did some distanced and masked interviews. It is different for sure, but it is working! I am optimistic about this year. And I am so excited for what lies ahead and all the possibilities. Please pray for this ministry and for our staff. We take great joy in serving you through RTLC. I am beginning my 33rd year at Rainbow Trail. I could not have asked for a better place to live over half my life and have the opportunity to serve you with all of my gifts. The RTLC community is our family. You have all become an integral part of our story. Thanks for being my partner all along the way! I can't wait to see what God has planned for us in 2021!

Great New Ways To Continue To Support RTLC

The support of our donors is key to our ministry thriving and growing. There are a multitude of ways that you can give to this ministry. Stocks, bonds, mutual and ETF funds, checks, online, and gifts to annual support or specific projects like the land exchange or camperships are just a few. However, there are some other tools available of which you may not be aware

If you own an IRA and are over the age 70 1/2 you may be eligible to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (ie a contribution to RTLC) directly from your IRA and not include the amount given as subject to income tax. And such charitable gifts reduce the amount of Required Minimum Distribution you must take for yourself every year! Because of recent law changes, it is always good to consult your tax advisor, but if you are eligible for this, it is a very good deal!

Donor Advised Funds (DAFs) are tax-advantaged investment accounts used for charitable giving. You can fund a DAF with cash or other assets and take a tax deduction for doing so. Usually, people opt to contribute their appreciated investments so they don't have to face the tax consequences of selling it themselves. Once inside the donor-advised fund, your contributions continue to grow tax-free until you elect to issue a grant to the IRS-approved charity of your choice.

The beauty of donor-advised funds is they're available to anyone. Donor-advised funds are "designed to be a simple, turnkey way to execute your philanthropic wishes, whether you're giving \$500 or several million." You can give as much or as little (as long as it's at least \$50) as you want to one charity or dozens whenever you choose. Many charitable gift experts call donor-advised funds "flexible philanthropy."

Hello to my RTLC Family! Today the sun is shining; it's 40 degrees out and wonders of wonders, the winds not blowing! I have been trying some new recipes that just might make a surprise appearance this summer! It will be SO great to see my people again! Things will still be done with the utmost care for our guests, so you will see many changes in procedures, all aimed at keeping you safe while still enjoying the "camp" experience! It's very encouraging to know that our excellent nurse Carla and Leah Jarvis, will be returning. They were both very instrumental in developing the protocols that we used every day. Since we had no reported cases from campers last year, I think they did a spectacular job. Thank You to you both!



Of course, the big guy (Dave) did his usual job of awesomeness! I don't know of another person who is so dedicated to his staff. Thank You, Dave!

We had to wish a very sad farewell to Kyle this year. You are loved and will be greatly missed! But have no fear! Sands Simonton is taking over! Sandy will be a great addition to our full-time staff.

So, now to some recipes and fun food facts! I thought it might be time for some good for the soul soup recipes. Both of these soups can be prepared as vegetarian dishes! The first is

"Black Bean Soup" this soup is great served with cornbread and a salad! You will need, 3c. Chopped onion, 2Tbl. Olive oil, 3Tbl. Minced garlic, 2c. Chopped red bell pepper, 1 can 28oz. Diced tomatoes with juice, 2-4oz. Cans green chiles, 1Tbl. Cumin, 2 boxes chicken or veggie broth, 8-15oz. Cans block beans sizeed and desired 1/2e. Bed wine viscost You see 15oz. Cans black beans, rinsed and drained, 1/2c. Red wine vinegar. You can also add 2lbs.of cooked ground beef or diced chicken. I like to add a whole jalapeno finely chopped, seeds and membranes removed. Bring the heat! To prepare, heat oil in a stockpot. Saute onions, bell pepper, and garlic till tender. Add remaining ingredients to the pot; bring to a boil. Reduce heat cover and simmer for ½ hour. Serve topped with sour cream, fresh cilantro, and


The next soup is "Beef Tortellini Soup." You will need 1lb. Cooked and drained ground beef, 3c. Water, 1-28oz. Can tomato puree, 1 envelope onion soup mix, 9oz. Frozen green beans, 1tsp. Italian Seasoning, 1tsp. Garlic powder, 2 bay leaves, 1tsp. Salt, 1tsp. Pepper, 9oz. Cheese tortellini (frozen or refrigerated). To prepare, add all ingredients to the pot except for tortellini. Bring to a boil. Cover and reduce heat to simmer for 30min. Add tortellini and cook till tender. This is great served with some crusty rolls and a spinach

salad! As always, add stuff and make it your own!

Now to some fun food facts. Caesar Salad was named after a restaurant owner in Tijuana, Mexico. Caesar Cardini was in trouble and was running out of food, so he used the only ingredients left and invented Caesar Salad! After you boil potatoes, try using the water in your bread recipe, and the bread will stay fresher longer at room temp. If you run out of yeast and need to make rolls, try using a tsp of baking soda and an equal amount of vitamin C. The results will be the same since a similar chemical reaction occurs. The secret to light dumplings is to puncture them when they are finished cooking to allow the air to circulate inside. Colas have a higher physiological dependence than smoking and alcohol and are harder to give up. Suppose you add 1 and ½ tsp. Butter to a portion of cooking pasta or soup. It will not boil over. When flare-ups from fat drippings start to burn the meat, place lettuce leaves over the hot coals to eliminate the problem. The first known recipe for ice cream was brought to Venice, Italy, by Marco Polo after a Japan journey. The Italians then introduced "Cream Ice" to Europe and later

"Ice Cream" by our own Dolly Madison for a White House function. Well, this is where I end this issue! I pray daily for all of you! May you stay healthy, happy, and loved! Always remember; God is Great!
