2022 RAINBOW TRAIL LUTHERAN CAMP COVID AND HEALTH PROTOCOLS FOR THIS RETREAT SEASON

Hello RETREATERS!

In consultation with our Camp Physician, Dr. Mohr, and Custer County Public Health Officials, we've made the following adjustments to our COVID protocols:

- A negative home antigen test within 48 hours of arrival at camp is STRONGLY recommended and will provide an additional layer of comfort.
- We are asking you to please bring at least two well-fitting masks with you. We'll
 be only masking in food lines and around food service. Masks are not required
 other times although personal preference is honored.
- We will continue to provide hand sanitizer outside of all of our major buildings.
 We ask that you sanitize going in and coming out of our buildings. Aso, excellent and frequent hand hygiene is part of our protocols.
- Anyone with symptoms will be isolated and tested with a home antigen test. If
 positive, the retreat participant will be sent home. If negative, the retreat
 participant will isolate, will be required to mask, and will be closely monitored.
- We also have antigen tests for anyone presenting with symptoms.
- Thanks in advance for working with us.
- All recommendations are subject to change based on updated guidance from the State, Custer County Public Health, CDC and RTLC Board.
